

## **EPIC-MRA STATEWIDE EXIT POLL – NOVEMBER 2, 2010**

[FREQUENCY REPORT OF AUTOMATED SURVEY RESPONSES – 2000 SAMPLE – ERROR ±2.9%]

Today is election day, and EPIC-MRA, a Lansing based survey research firm, is conducting a very short survey for media outlets to determine which candidates voters supported today for the major statewide offices.

In the election for Michigan Governor, please press #1 if you voted for Rick Snyder, the Republican -- press #3 if you voted for Virg Bernero, the Democrat -- press #5 if you voted for some other minor party candidate, and press #7 if for some reason you decided not to vote for any candidate in the race for governor.

**60% Snyder the Republican**  
**37% Bernero the Democrat**  
**3% A minor party candidate**

In the election for Secretary of State, please press #1 if you voted for Ruth Johnson, the Republican -- press #3 if you voted for Jocelyn (JOSS-uh-lynn) Benson, the Democrat -- press #5 if you voted for some other candidate – press #7 if you did not vote for any candidate in the race for Secretary of State.

**54% Ruth Johnson the Republican**  
**42% Jocelyn Benson the Democrat**  
**4% A minor party candidate**

In the election for Attorney General, please press #1 if you voted for Bill Schuette (SHOO-tee), the Republican -- press #3 if you voted for David Leyton, the Democrat -- press #5 if you voted for some other candidate – press #7 if you did not vote for any candidate in the race for Attorney General.

**56% Bill Schuette the Republican**  
**39% David Leyton the Democrat**  
**5% A minor party candidate**

**COMBINED – PICK TWO.** In the election for Michigan Supreme Court, you can vote for up to two candidates. Please press the number on your phone keypad to indicate which of the following candidates was your first choice in the race for Michigan Supreme Court. You will be asked a follow-up question to get your second choice. In your first choice, if you voted for Incumbent Justice Alton Davis, please press #1 -- if you voted for Mary Beth Kelly, press #3 – if you voted Incumbent Justice Bob Young, press #5 ---- if you voted for Denise Langford Morris, press #7, if you voted for Bob Roddis (ROW-diss) press #9 – and if you DID NOT for any candidate running for Michigan Supreme Court, please press #0.

**22% Incumbent Justice Alton Davis**  
**37% Mary Beth Kelly**  
**25% Incumbent Justice Bob Young**  
**14% Denise Langford Morris**  
**2% Bob Roddis**

Proposal 1 would call for a constitutional convention. Press #1 if you voted “YES” to approve of Proposal 1 to call for a constitutional convention, Press #3 if you voted “NO,” Press #5 if you did not vote one way or the other on Proposal 1.

**28% Yes on Proposal 1**  
**72% No on Proposal 1**

If you consider yourself a Democrat or mostly vote for Democrats, please press #1 – if you consider yourself a Republican or mostly vote for Republicans, press #3 – if you consider yourself an Independent and do not vote for candidates from one major political party any more than candidates from the other party, press #5 – if you consider yourself a member of any third party or minor political party, please press #7.

**37% Democrat**  
**44% Republican**  
**19% Independent**

Finally, if your gender is male, press #1 – if your gender is female, press #3

**47% Male**  
**53% Female**
